

## **Dignity for Children Foundation – Tax Exemption Receipt Information**

- ***What donations are tax deductible?***

Effective 1 January 2023, the following donations to Dignity for Children Foundation are tax deductible:

1. Cash donations for the benefit of all Malaysians irrespective of their race, religion, or political affiliation.
2. Applicable only to donations made within Malaysia.
3. Donation of goods in kind are not tax deductible."

- ***Can I get a tax exemption receipt?***

In compliance with guidelines issued by the Malaysian tax authority, Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri (LHDN), donors **must** provide the following details in order to obtain an official tax-exemption receipt from the approved organisation:"

- a) Donor's full name as per NRIC / Passport: \_\_\_\_\_
- b) NRIC number / passport number: \_\_\_\_\_
- c) Full mailing address of current residence: \_\_\_\_\_

**Please note that we will not issue tax-exemption receipts to donors who fail to provide their complete personal details stated above.**
