Currently, there are 4 Transformational Enterprises in operations and a Farm Academy in Bentong, Pahang.

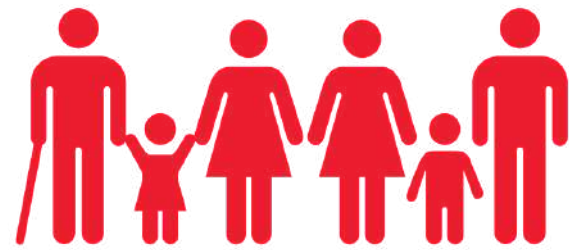
## Who do we serve?

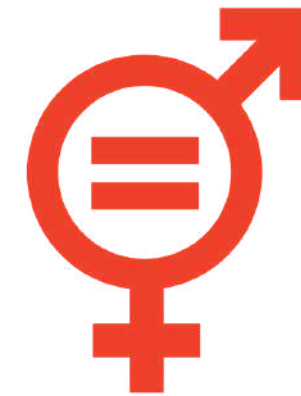
Dignity runs quality education programs for toddlers to high school and beyond.

## Formative Years Education (FYE)

Children learn from the 6 main areas of the Montessori curriculum – Practical Life, Sensorial, Language, Mathematics, Science and Culture and Art.



## Primary Education

Dignity Primary Program delivers the Malaysian academic syllabus supplemented with materials from Singapore and the UK. Classes are in English medium.



## Secondary Education

At the Dignity Secondary program, we pursue meaningful learning and academic excellence so that students are prepared to sit for the O'level examinations (IGCSE) at Form 5 level.
